



How Can I use Mid-Term Course Evaluations for Pedagogical Improvement?

Background

Mid-term course evaluations provide a means for collecting information about the students' experiences in a given course at a point in the semester which allows instructors to make adjustments to their instruction before summative evaluations are administered. Student evaluations have proven to be a stable, reliable, and multi-dimensional tool that permits instructors to target feedback regarding discrete aspects of instruction.¹

In designing one's own instrument with input from departmental members, the instructor may address key learning outcomes of a given program, and strategies particular to the instructor. The evaluation may target students' experiences with research, field work, and key assignments. Ideally, the data will inform the instructor about the pace, clarity, organization, and meaningfulness of instruction.
